Oscar's parents parked the car and went inside to tell the manager. The manager came outside with a net and a box and put the penguin safely inside so he could carry it back to the other penguins.

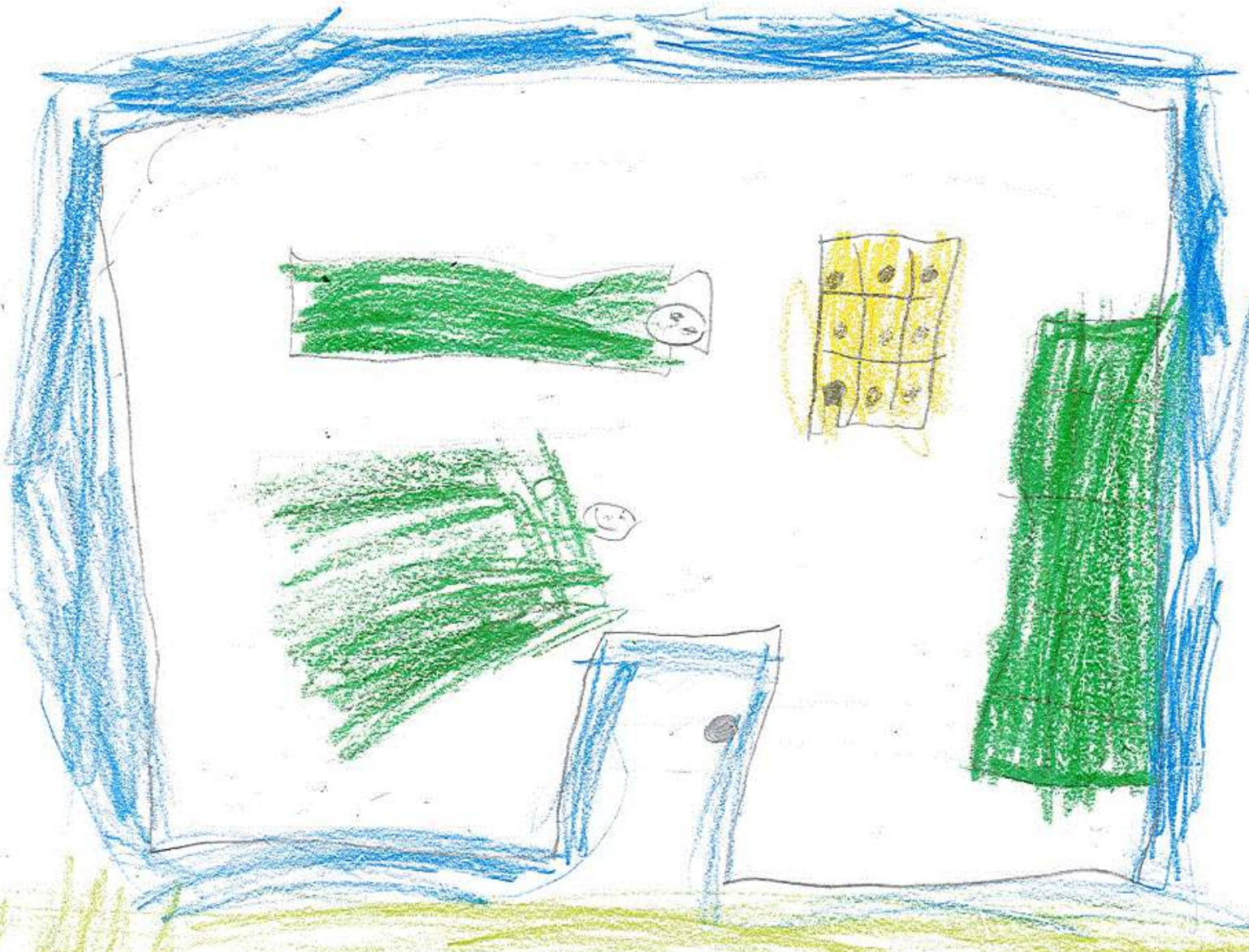
He was so thankful that he decided to give Oscar an award for doing the right thing.

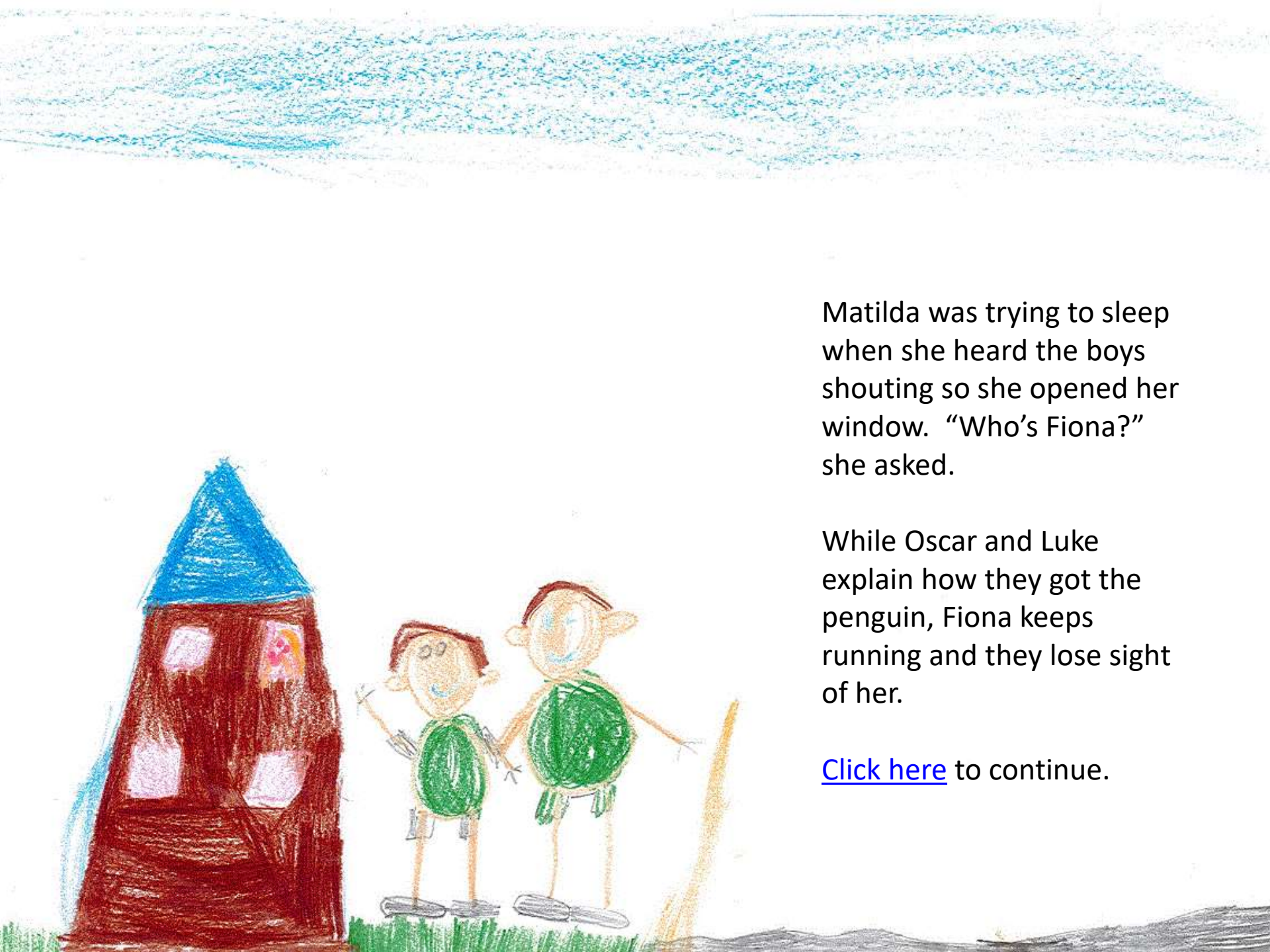

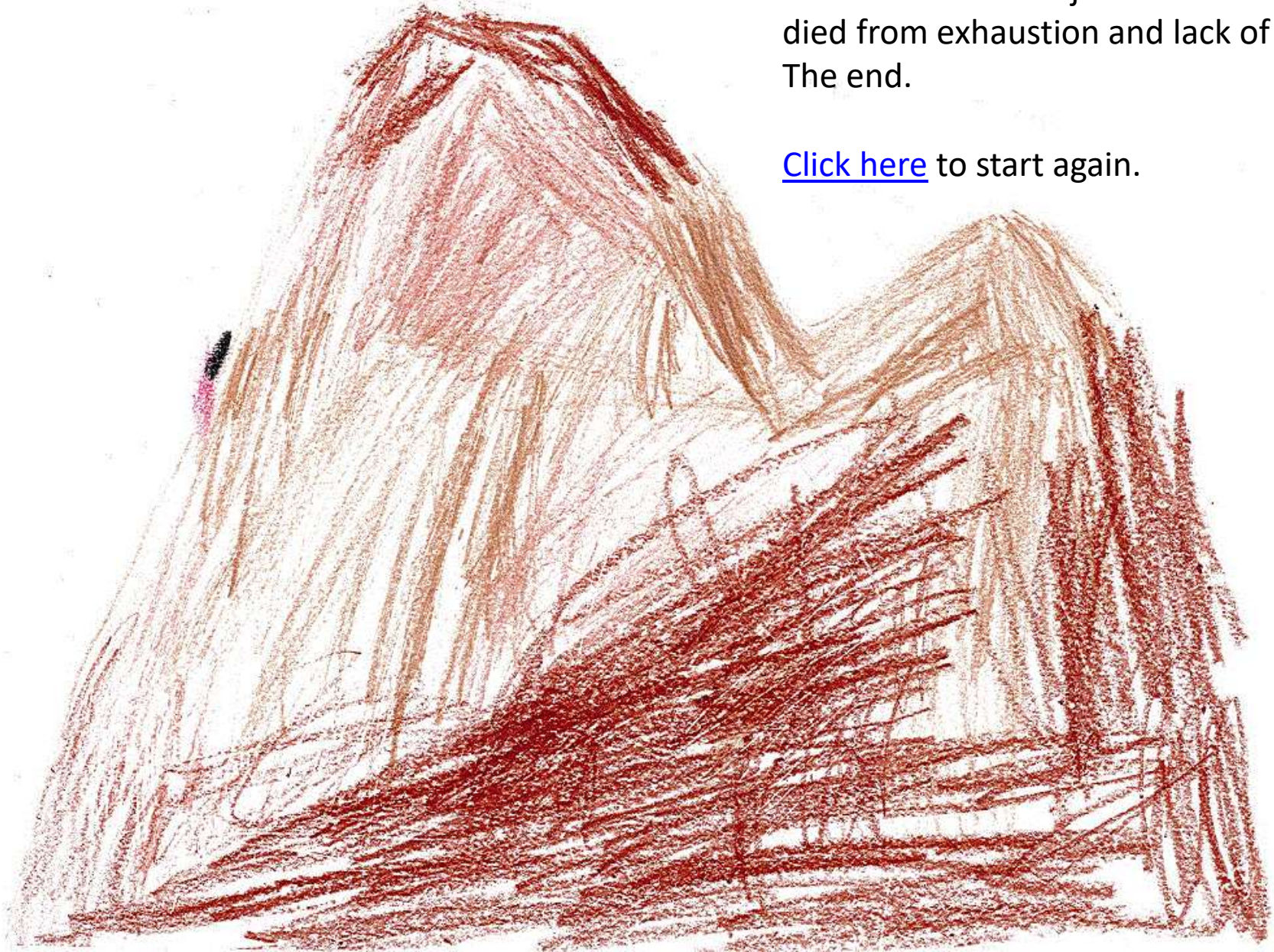
Matilda was trying to sleep when she heard the boys shouting so she opened her window. “Who’s Fiona?” she asked.

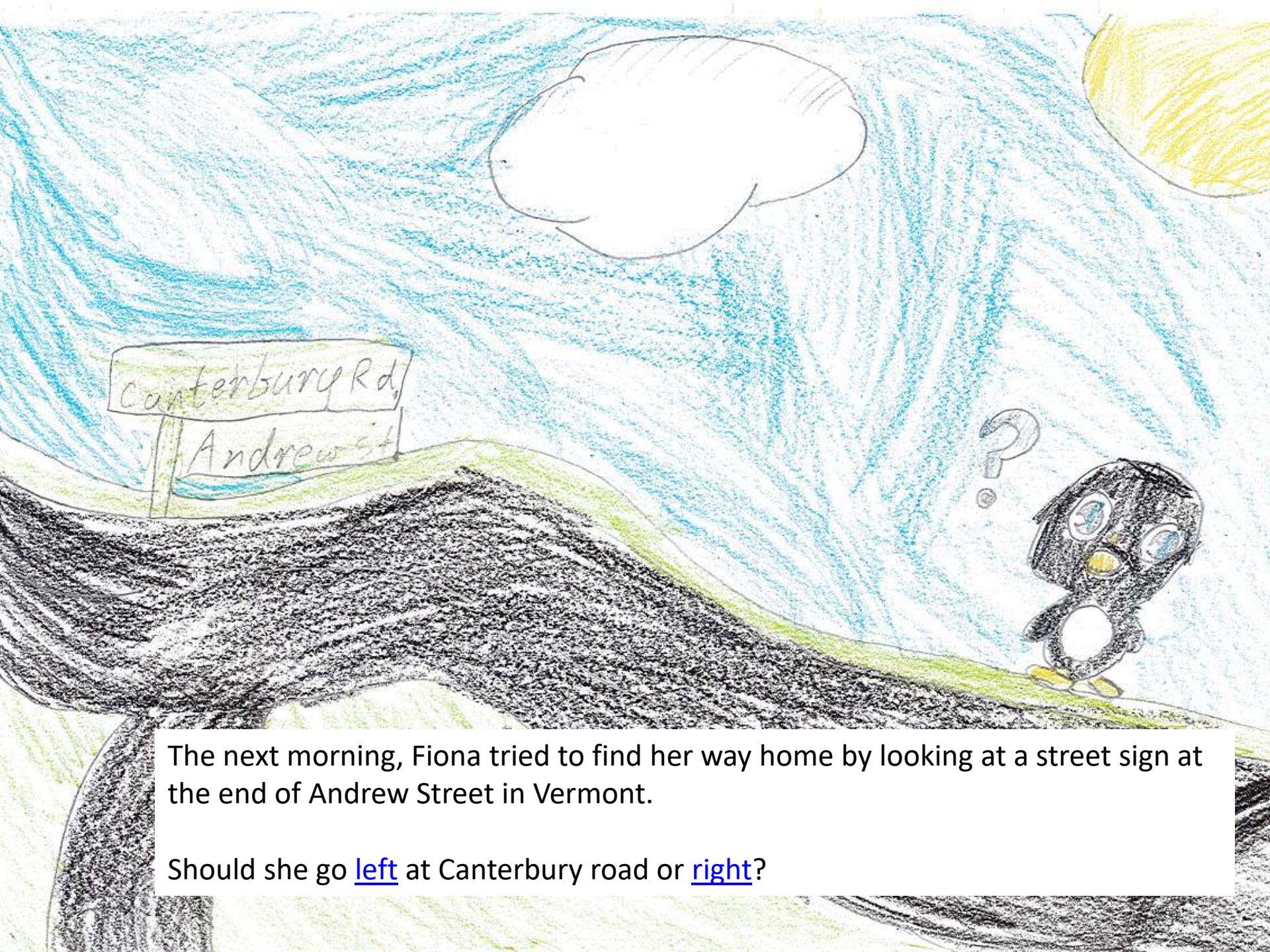
As Fiona continued to run from the boys, she came across a police woman named "Olivia".

Olivia would have been able to help Fiona get back to Phillip Island but Fiona was scared of Olivia because she looked like a big blue penguin in her uniform.



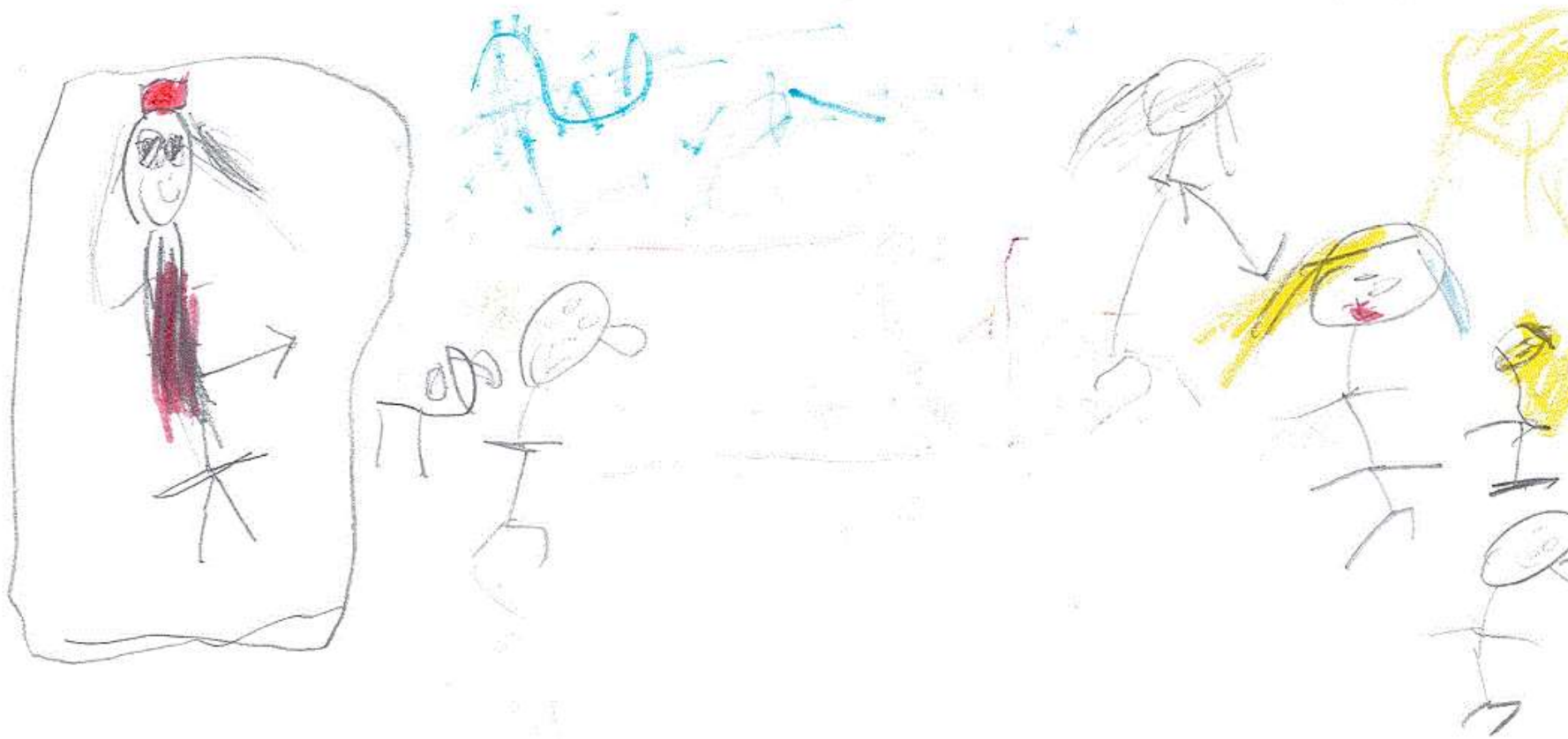
Fiona fell asleep while she was hiding in some bushes.

The next morning, Fiona tried to find her way home by looking at a street sign at the end of Andrew Street in Vermont.

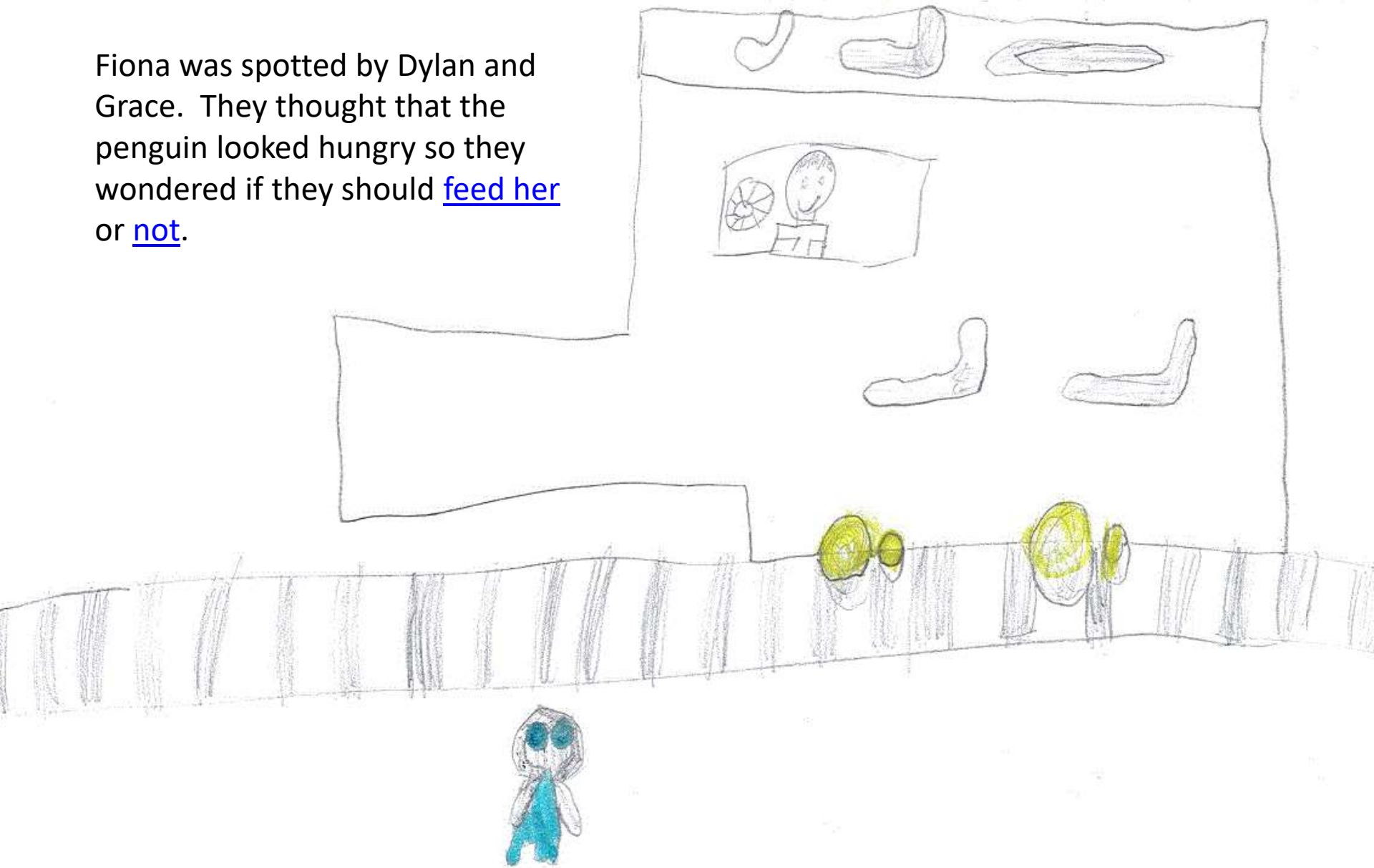
Should she go left at Canterbury road or right?

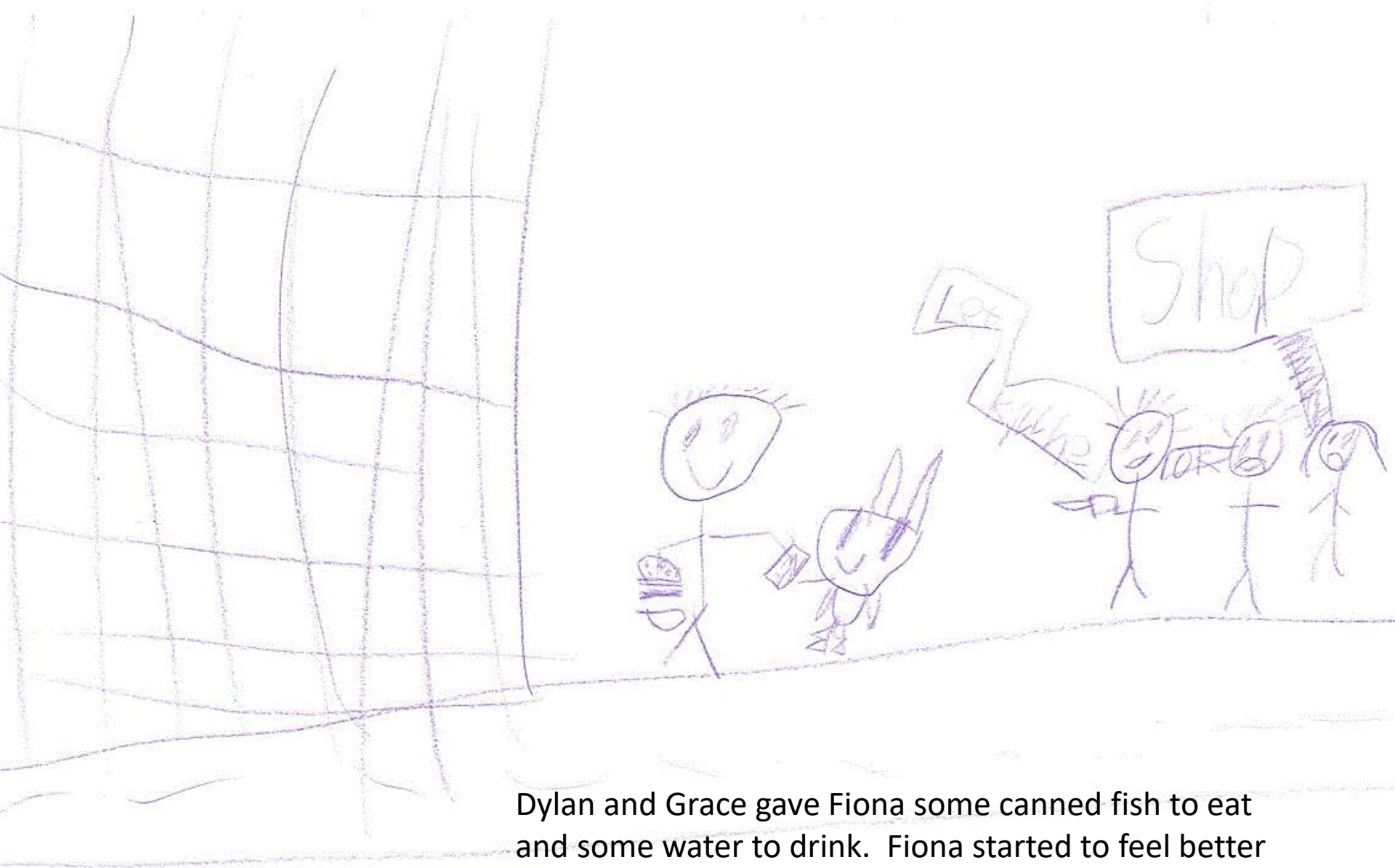

Fiona was spotted by Dylan and Grace. They thought that the penguin looked hungry so they wondered if they should feed her or not.

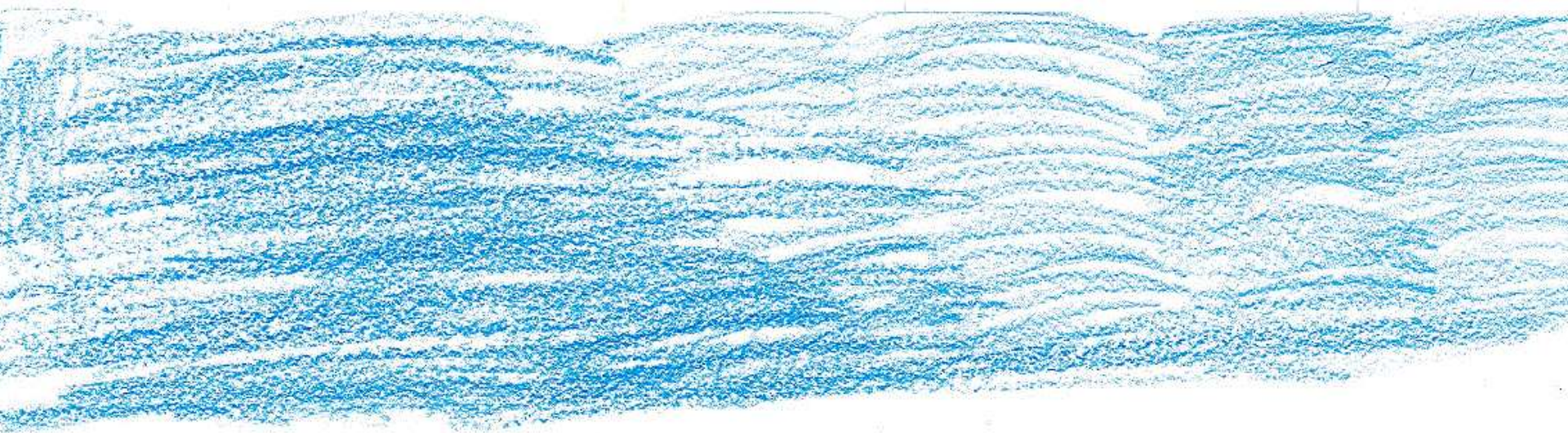




Dylan and Grace gave Fiona some canned fish to eat and some water to drink. Fiona started to feel better so she had the strength to [keep on going](#).



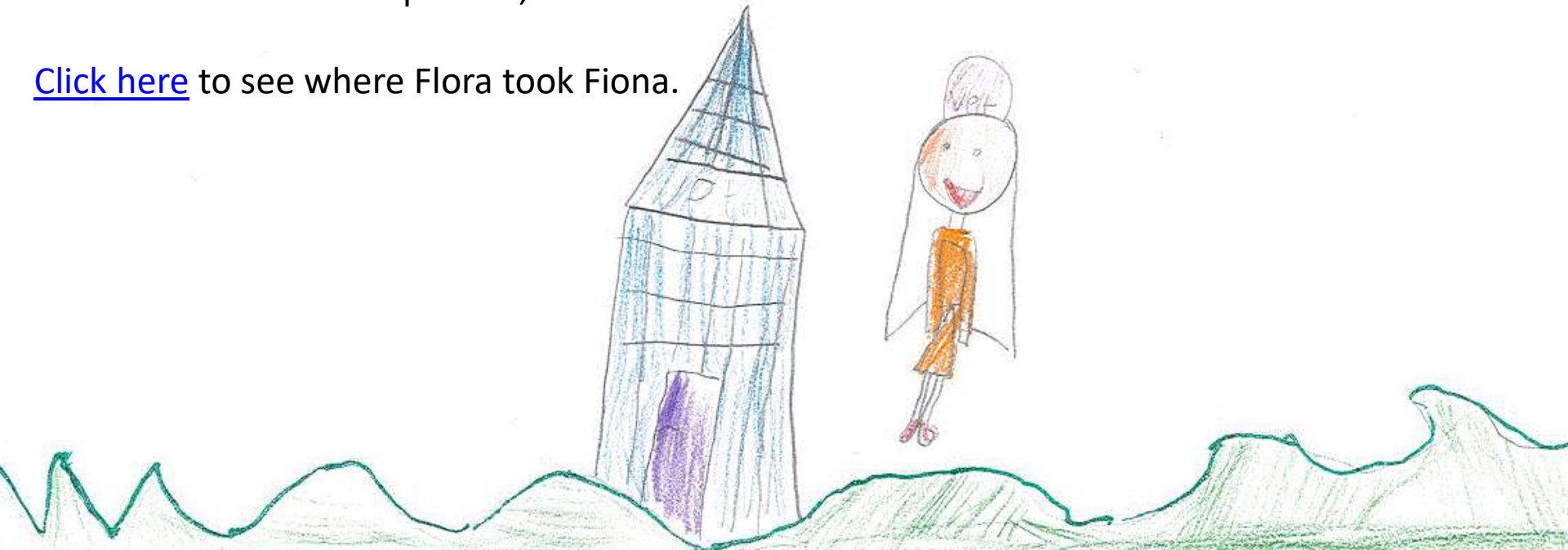
You decided not to feed the penguin because it was a wild animal.

The vet was a nice lady called “Flora”. They had to wait a long time because Flora was busy seeing Emily and her eleven chickens.

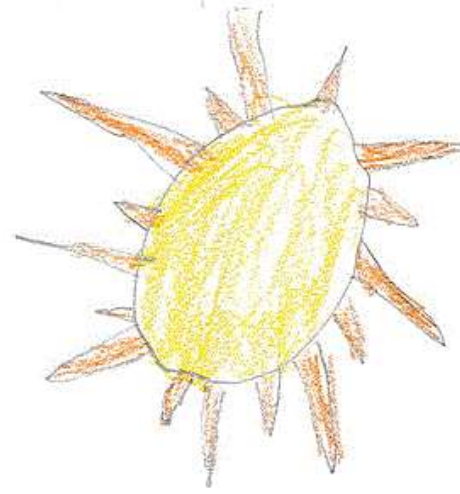
When Flora had fixed up Fiona, she knew that Fiona had to be taken somewhere else.

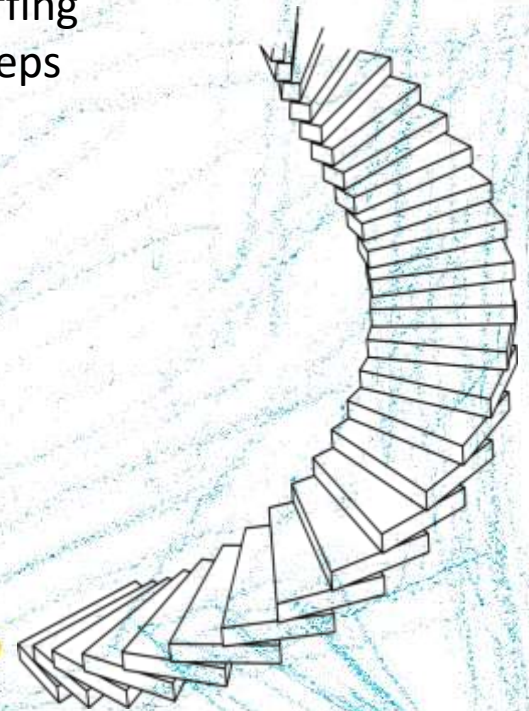
Fiona walked and walked until she came to the Dandenong Mountains. It was beautiful in the mountains but Fiona was still lost!

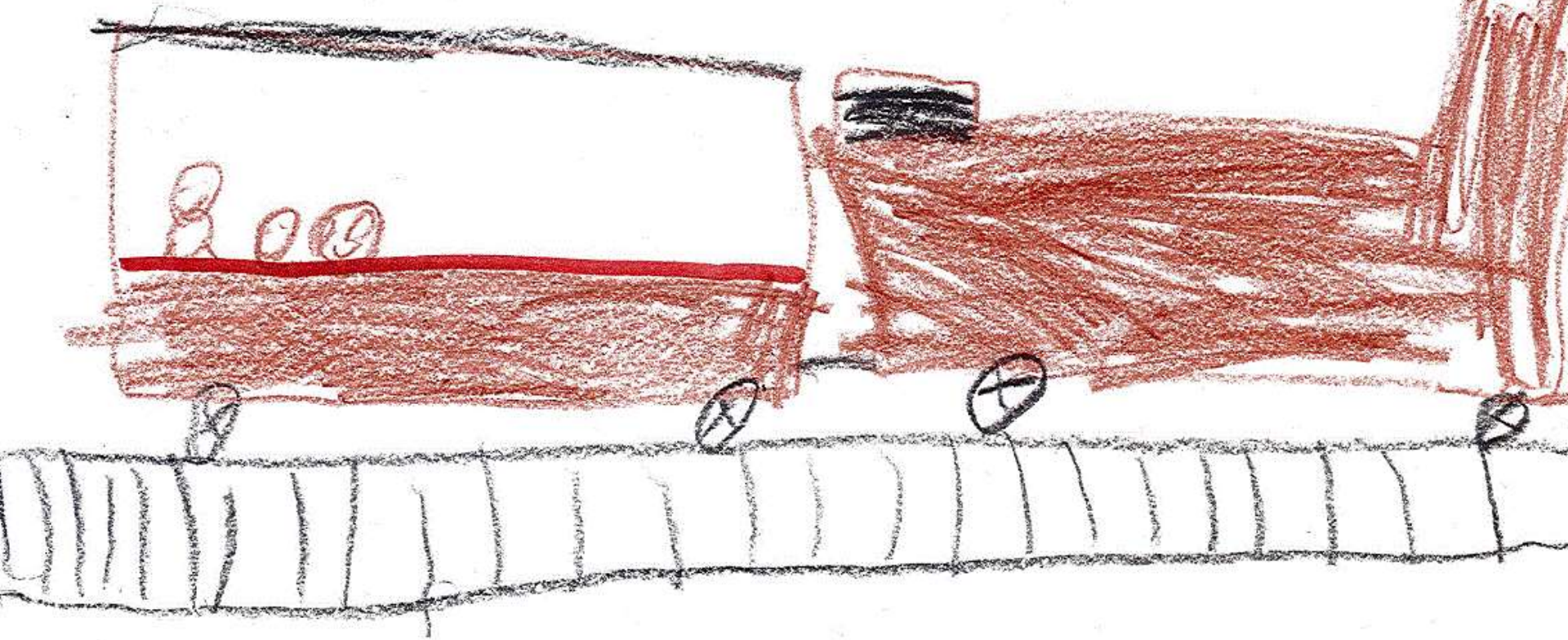

She was very happy to be back with her friends and family.

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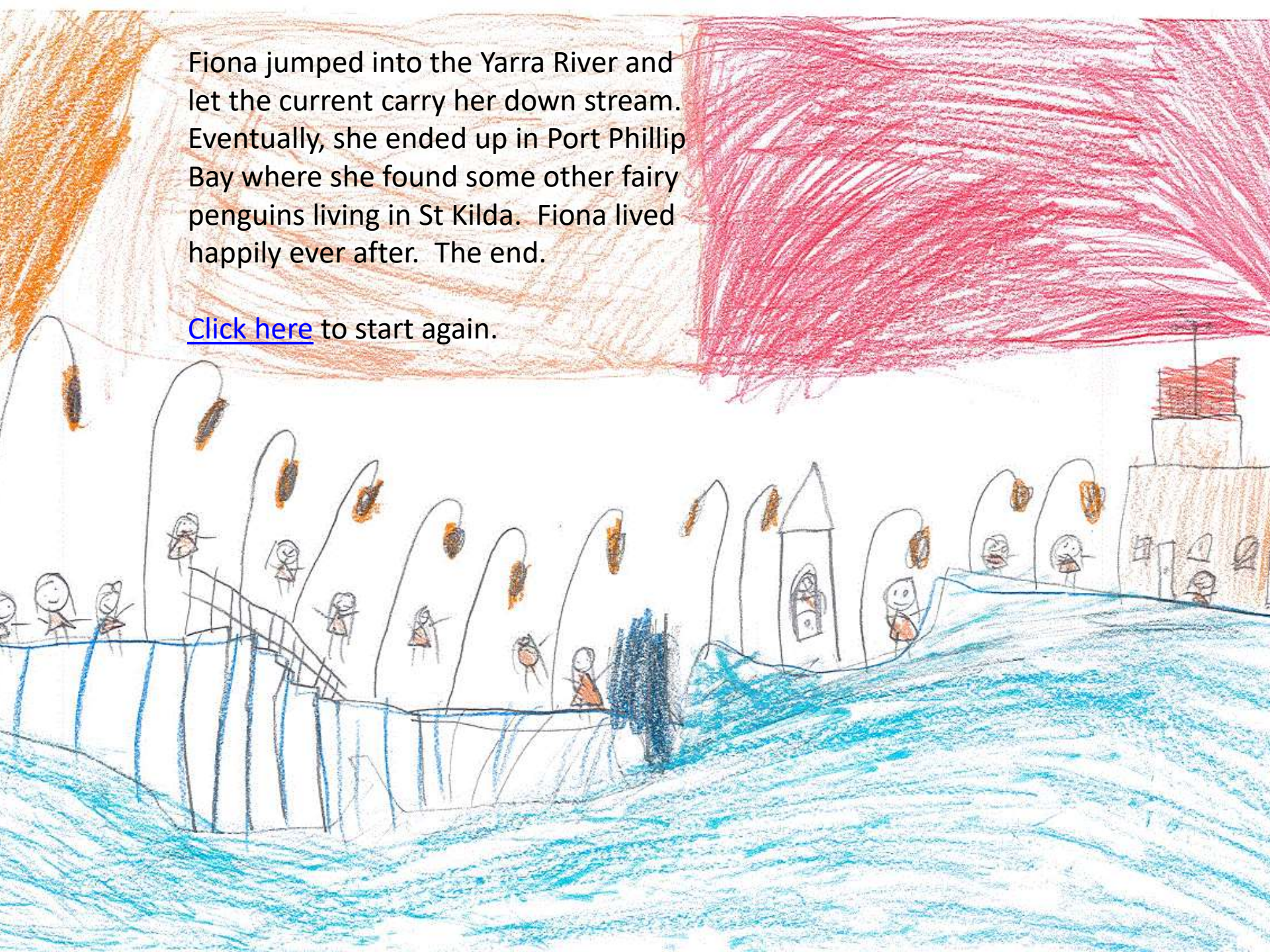
Fiona came to the Yarra River but she didn't like it because it was fresh water instead of salt water. Fiona was clever enough to know that it might lead to salt water.

Should Fiona follow the river [upstream](#) or [downstream](#)?



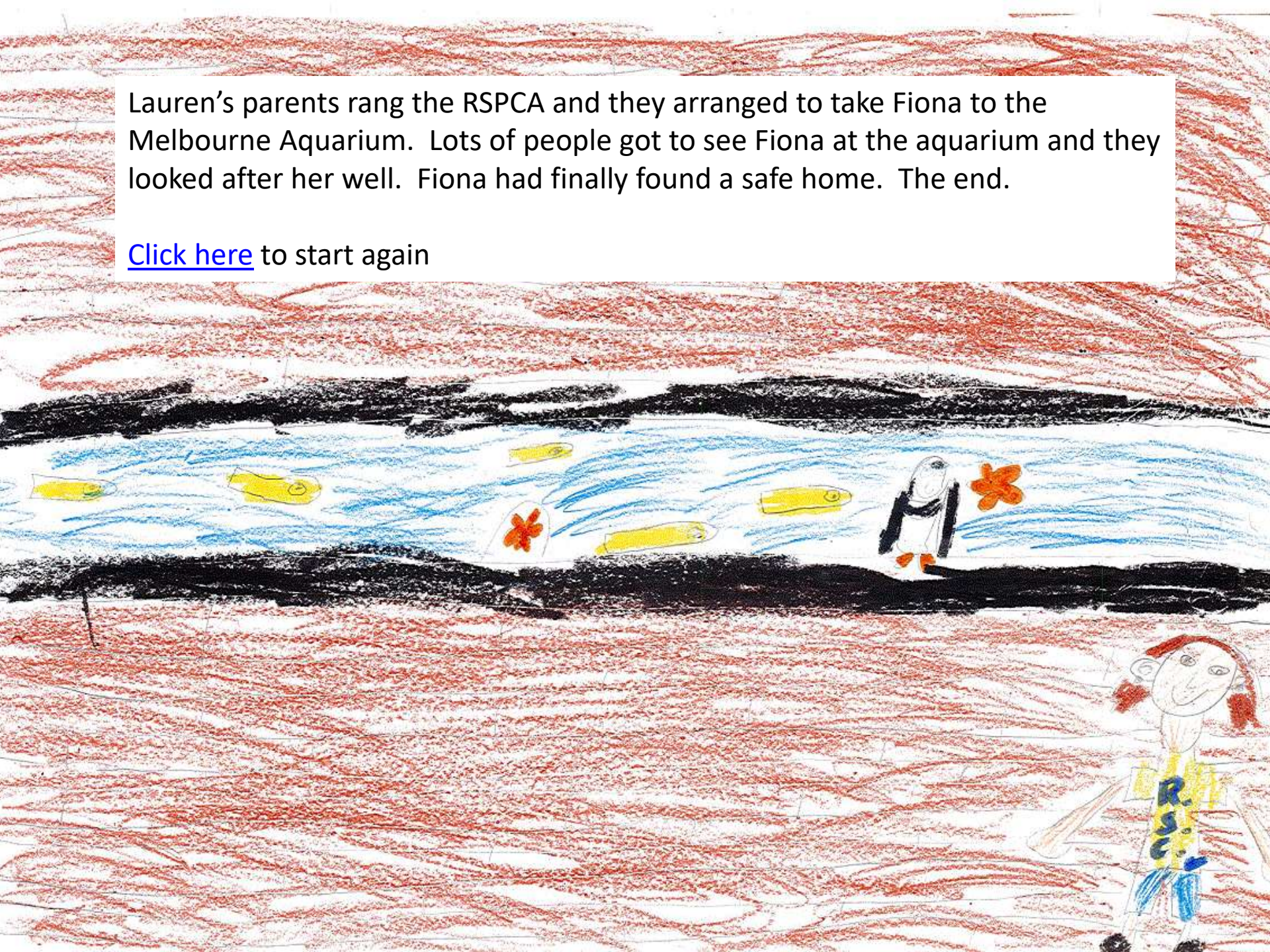
